



COVID-19 PROCEDURES FOR MOTORCOACHES

At Fisher Bus Inc, the health and well being of our customers and staff is our utmost priority. To ensure we are safeguarding both our employees and passengers throughout the duration of this pandemic and beyond, we have incorporated the following procedures into our cleaning and maintenance efforts.

- Prior to departure all vehicles are thoroughly cleaned. This includes wiping down lavatory with disinfectants and dumping of wastewater, mopping floor with disinfectant cleaner, and spraying disinfectant products that meet EPA's criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2 throughout entire cabin paying special attention to handrails, lavatory, and driver dashboard.
- Passengers and drivers are encouraged to sanitize their hands upon entering the vehicle utilizing the hand sanitizer dispensers that have been mounted at the entrance of each motor coach and lavatory. Dispensers contain an alcohol-based hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol.
- We have stocked face masks in our vehicles that can be offered upon request.
- Air Filters in all cabin ventilation systems are cleaned/replaced in excess of manufactures recommended schedule.
